

Public Advocate shall oversee the performance of an audit of the

market mechanism from the beginning of calendar year 1985 to the
6 end of calendar year 1992. The Public Advocate may employ a
consultant to carry out the audit, subject to an appropriation of
necessary funds by the Legislature.
