## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires that a candidate must submit evidence of tampering or irregularity to obtain a recount in an election in which the margin of victory is more than 75 votes in an election for the House of Representatives or a municipal election or 300 votes in an election to the Senate or a county or statewide election.
