2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §1652, sub-§2,** as enacted by PL 1987, c. 804,
is amended to read:

6 **2. Schools.** A school or school administrative district
8 shall comply with the provisions of this section except that a
food service providing such services to satellite facilities at
10 the school or school administrative district serviced by central
kitchen facilities not at the same location is exempt. A school
12 or school administrative district may use containers that are
composed in whole or in part of polystyrene foam in their food
14 service program if an active recycling program is in place for
these containers.

18 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

20 This bill allows schools or school administrative districts
22 with an active polystyrene recycling program to use these
containers in their food service programs.
