

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **PART A**

6 **Sec. A-1. 5 MRSA §12004-I, sub-§78-A,** as enacted by PL 1989,  
c. 811, §1, is repealed.

8 **Sec. A-2. 5 MRSA §18802,** as enacted by PL 1989, c. 811, §3,  
is repealed.

10 **PART B**

12 **Sec. B-1. 5 MRSA §12004-J, sub-§8,** as enacted by PL 1989, c.  
14 547, §1 and affected by §5, is repealed.

16 **Sec. B-2. 37-B MRSA §521,** as enacted by PL 1989, c. 547, §3,  
is repealed.

18 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

20 **Part A** repeals the Participating Local District Advisory  
22 Committee.

24 **Part B** repeals the Commission on Vietnam and Atomic Veterans.

26 This bill is submitted in compliance with Public Law 1991,  
28 chapter 844, section 8, which requires the Secretary of State to  
submit legislation repealing all advisory boards and commissions  
30 listed in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, sections 12004-I  
and 12004-J as well as other advisory boards and commissions with  
32 similar functions.

34 Pursuant to that law, the boards and commissions have been  
grouped by the subject areas within the jurisdiction of each  
36 joint standing committee and each special select committee. This  
bill repeals certain boards and commissions identified within the  
38 jurisdiction of the Joint Standing Committee on Aging, Retirement  
and Veterans.
