

An Act Repealing Advisory Boards on Agriculture Matters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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PART A

Sec. A-1. 5 MRSA §12004-I, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 786, §5, is repealed.

PART B

Sec. B-1. 5 MRSA §12004-I, sub-§2-A, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 609, §1, is repealed.

Sec. B-2. 7 MRSA §2403, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 609, §2, is repealed.

PART C

Sec. C-1. 5 MRSA §12004-I, sub-§2-B, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 779, §2, is repealed.

Sec. C-2. 7 MRSA §3903-A, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 779, §4, is repealed.

PART D

Sec. D-1. 5 MRSA §12004-I, sub-§2-C, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 779, §2, is repealed.

Sec. D-2. 7 MRSA §3906-C, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 779, §10, is repealed.

PART E

STATEMENT OF FACT

Part A repeals the Maine Agricultural Viability Advisory Committee.

Part B repeals the Integrated Pest Management Advisory Committee.

Part C repeals the Animal Welfare Board.

2 Part D repeals the Animal Welfare Advisory Committee.

4 Part E repeals the Commission on Biotechnology and Genetic
Engineering.

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8 This bill is submitted in compliance with Public Law 1991,
chapter 844, section 8, which requires the Secretary of State to
10 submit legislation repealing all advisory boards and commissions
listed in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, sections 12004-I
and 12004-J as well as other advisory boards and commissions with
12 similar functions.

14 Pursuant to that law, the boards and commissions have been
grouped by the subject areas within the jurisdiction of each
16 joint standing committee and each special select committee. This
bill repeals certain boards and commissions identified within the
18 jurisdiction of the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture.
