

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 PART A

6 Sec. A-1. 5 MRSA §884, as amended by PL 1991, c. 780, Pt. Y,  
§§32 and 33, is repealed.

8 Sec. A-2. 5 MRSA §12004-I, sub-§25, as enacted by PL 1987, c.  
10 786, §5, is repealed.

12 PART B

14 Sec. B-1. 5 MRSA §1658, as amended by PL 1991, c. 780, Pt. Y,  
§46, is repealed.

16 Sec. B-2. 5 MRSA §12004-I, sub-§29, as enacted by PL 1987, c.  
18 786, §5, is repealed.

20 STATEMENT OF FACT

22 Part A repeals the Advisory Council on Deferred Compensation  
24 Plans.

26 Part B repeals the Advisory Committee on Single State Audits.

28 This bill is submitted in compliance with Public Law 1991,  
chapter 844, section 8, which requires the Secretary of State to  
30 submit legislation repealing all advisory boards and commissions  
32 listed in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, sections 12004-I  
and 12004-J as well as other advisory boards and commissions with  
similar functions.

34 Pursuant to that law, the boards and commissions have been  
36 grouped by the subject areas within the jurisdiction of each  
joint standing committee and each special select committee. This  
38 bill repeals certain boards and commissions identified within the  
jurisdiction of the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations  
40 and Financial Affairs.
