

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §12004-I, sub-§2-D,** as renumbered by RR 1991,  
c. 2, §11, is repealed.

6 **Sec. 2. 10 MRSA §1678,** as corrected by RR 1991, c. 2, §34, is  
8 repealed.

10 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

12 This bill repeals the Petroleum Advisory Committee.

14 This bill is submitted in compliance with Public Law 1991,  
16 chapter 844, section 8, which requires the Secretary of State to  
submit legislation repealing all advisory boards and commissions  
18 listed in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, sections 12004-I  
and 12004-J as well as other advisory boards and commissions with  
20 similar functions.

22 Pursuant to that law, the boards and commissions have been  
grouped by the subject areas within the jurisdiction of each  
24 joint standing committee and each special select committee. This  
bill repeals certain boards and commissions identified within the  
26 jurisdiction of the Joint Standing Committee on Business  
Legislation.
