COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 803, L.D. 1089, Bill, "An Act Repealing Advisory Boards on Education Matters"

Amend the bill by striking out all of Part A.

Further amend the bill in Part B by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. B-2. 20-A MRSA c. 430-A, as amended, is repealed.'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of Part C.

Further amend the bill in Part E by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. E-2. 20-A MRSA §202, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 693, §§5 and 8, is repealed.'

Further amend the bill in Part E by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill by striking out all of Parts F, G, I and K.

Further amend the bill by relettering the parts to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill by adding at the end before the statement of fact the following:

This amendment preserves the following boards and commissions within the jurisdiction of the Joint Standing Committee on Education: Advisory Committee on Medical Education; Maine Area Health Education Centers Advisory Committee; Policy Review Board; Policy Review Council; Truants and Dropouts Advisory Committee; and Maine Education Assistance Board.

The amendment repeals the Maine Choice Program, an inactive program, in addition to its advisory board and repeals a cross-reference to the Maine Educational Council. Finally, the amendment also adds a fiscal note.
