

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STATEMENT OF FACT

Part A repeals the Advisory Committee on Medical Education.

Part B repeals the Maine Choice Advisory Board.

Part C repeals the Maine Area Health Education Centers Advisory Committee.

Part D repeals the Advisory Committee for the Training of Firefighters.

Part E repeals the Maine Education Council.

Part F repeals the Policy Review Board.

Part G repeals the Policy Review Council.

Part H repeals the Advisory Committee on Student Assessment.

Part I repeals the Truants and Dropouts Advisory Committee.

Part J repeals the Advisory Committee on Early Elementary Education.

Part K repeals the Maine Education Assistance Board.

This bill is submitted in compliance with Public Law 1991, chapter 844, section 8, which requires the Secretary of State to submit legislation repealing all advisory boards and commissions listed in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, sections 12004-I and 12004-J as well as other advisory boards and commissions with similar functions.

Pursuant to that law, the boards and commissions have been grouped by the subject areas within the jurisdiction of each joint standing committee and each special select committee. This bill repeals certain boards and commissions identified within the jurisdiction of the Joint Standing Committee on Education.
