

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

Part A repeals the Advisory Council on Energy Efficiency Building Performance Standards.

Part B repeals the Waste Management Advisory Council.

Part C repeals the Toxics Reduction Advisory Council.

Part D repeals the Pollution Prevention Advisory Committee.

Part E repeals the Oil Spill Advisory Committee.

Part F repeals the Great Pond Task Force.

Part G repeals the Citizens' Advisory Group.

Part H repeals the Maine Critical Areas Advisory Board.

Part I repeals the Advisory Commission on Radioactive Waste.

Part J resolves a conflict and confirms the repeal of the Recycling Advisory Council.

This bill is submitted in compliance with Public Law 1991, chapter 844, section 8, which requires the Secretary of State to submit legislation repealing all advisory boards and commissions listed in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, sections 12004-I and 12004-J as well as other advisory boards and commissions with similar functions.

Pursuant to that law, the boards and commissions have been grouped by the subject areas within the jurisdiction of each joint standing committee and each special select committee. This bill repeals certain boards and commissions identified within the jurisdiction of the Joint Standing Committee on Energy and Natural Resources.
