
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**An Act Repealing Advisory Boards on Housing and Economic

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

Part A repeals the Commission on Job Opportunity Zones.

Part B repeals the Affordable Housing Alliance Advisory Committee.

Part C repeals the Commission on Investment Capital.

Part D repeals the Natural Resource Financing and Marketing Board.

Part E repeals the Advisory Board to the Maine State Housing Authority.

Part F repeals Passamaquoddy Indian Housing Authority at Indian Township and Pleasant Point and Penobscot Tribal Reservation Housing Authority.

Part G repeals the Maine Tourism Commission.

Part H repeals the Maine State Film Commission.

Part I repeals the Interagency Task Force on Homelessness and Housing Opportunities.

2 This bill is submitted in compliance with Public Law 1991,  
chapter 844, section 8, which requires the Secretary of State to  
4 submit legislation repealing all advisory boards and commissions  
and 12004-I as well as other advisory boards and commissions with  
6 similar functions.

8 Pursuant to that law, the boards and commissions have been  
grouped by the subject areas within the jurisdiction of each  
10 joint standing committee and each special select committee. This  
bill repeals certain boards and commissions within the  
12 jurisdiction of the Joint Standing Committee on Housing and  
Economic Development.

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
