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

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

36 Part A repeals the Judicial Council.

38 Part B repeals the Criminal Law Advisory Commission.

44 This bill is submitted in compliance with Public Law 1991, chapter 844, section 8, which requires the Secretary of State to

2 submit legislation repealing all advisory boards and commissions
3 listed in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, sections 12004-I
4 and 12004-J as well as other advisory boards and commissions with
5 similar functions.

6 Pursuant to that law, the boards and commissions have been
7 grouped by the subject areas within the jurisdiction of each
8 joint standing committee and each special select committee. This
9 bill repeals certain boards and commissions identified within the
10 jurisdiction of the Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary.
