COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 810, L.D. 1096, Bill, "An Act Repealing Advisory Boards on State and Local Government Matters"

Amend the bill by striking out all of Parts A, B, C, D and E (page 1, lines 3 to 45 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill in Part F by inserting before section 1 the following:

'Sec. F-1. 5 MRSA §298, 5th ¶, as amended by PL 1987, c. 816, Pt. EE, §3, is further amended to read:

The Director of Public Improvements shall--serve serves as the secretariat of the commission in exercising its administration. The commission may, in accordance with the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, chapter 375, adopt and enforce rules as it deems determines necessary, except rules relating to the State Capitol Building under the jurisdiction of the State Capitol-Commission State House and Capitol Park Commission, as it deems determines necessary for the purposes of carrying out this chapter. These rules shall have the full force and--effect of law.'

Further amend the bill in Part F by inserting after section F-1 the following:

'Sec. F-2. 27 MRSA §86-A, first ¶, as amended by PL 1987, c. 816, Pt. EE, §6, is further amended to read:

The Maine State Museum shall--held holds title, as trustee for the State, to all historical materials, other than documents or other library or archival items under the administrative jurisdiction of the Maine State Library or the Maine State Archives, which that are or may become the property of the State and are or may be housed in the public buildings of the State. Such These historical materials shall include the banners and

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2 flags presently housed in the State House Hall of Flags and may
3 include, but shall are not be restricted to, paintings,
4 sculptures and other works of art dealing with historic subjects
5 or executed by historically significant artists; flags, banners,
6 insignia, medals, firearms, edged weapons, uniforms and other
7 accoutrements relating to Maine military personnel or units;
8 furnishings, utensils, implements, tools, machinery and other
9 devices having particular historical significance to the State.

14 Further amend the bill by striking out all of Parts G and H
15 (page 2, lines 5 to 20 in L.D.)

18 Further amend the bill in Part I by inserting before section
19 I-1 the following:

20 'Sec. I-1. 2 MRSA §1, 4th ¶, as repealed and replaced by PL
21 1985, c. 693, §1, is repealed.'

24 Further amend the bill in Part I by renumbering the sections
25 to read consecutively.

26 Further amend the bill in Part J by inserting after section
27 J-1 the following:

30 'Sec. J-2. 5 MRSA §351, as amended by PL 1991, c. 780, Pt. Y,
31 §29, is repealed.'

32 'Sec. J-3. 5 MRSA §352, as amended by PL 1985, c. 785, Pt. A,
33 §37, is repealed.'

38 Further amend the bill by striking out all of Part L (page
39 2, line 50 and page 3, lines 2 to 6 in L.D.)

42 Further amend the bill by relettering the Parts to read

44 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the
45 statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

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The Department of the Secretary of State, the Department of Administrative and Financial Services and the Legislature will realize some minor administrative savings resulting from the repeal of the boards and commissions specified in this bill.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The amendment:

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1. Removes Part A of the bill, thereby retaining the Archives Advisory Board;

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2. Removes Part B of the bill, thereby retaining the Educational Leave Advisory Board;

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3. Removes Part C of the bill, thereby retaining the Board of Emergency Municipal Finance;

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4. Removes Part D of the bill, thereby retaining the Local Government Records Board;

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5. Removes Part E of the bill, thereby retaining the regional councils of governments;

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6. Adds necessary language amending cross-references to the State Capitol Commission;

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7. Removes Part G of the bill, thereby retaining the Capitol Planning Commission;

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8. Removes Part H of the bill, thereby retaining the State House and Capitol Park Commission;

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9. Amends Parts I and J of the bill to amend cross-references to the State Compensation Commission, the Advisory Committee on State Telecommunication and Maine-New Hampshire Boundary Commission and to repeal elements of the laws relating to those entities; and

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10. Removes Part L of the bill, thereby retaining the Maine-Canadian Legislative Advisory Commission.
