

26 Part I repeals the State Compensation Commission.
28 Part J repeals the Advisory Committee on State
30 Telecommunications.
32 Part K repeals the Maine-New Hampshire Boundary Commission.
34 Part L repeals the Maine-Canadian Legislative Advisory
Commission.

36 This bill is submitted in compliance with Public Law 1991,
38 chapter 844, section 8, which requires the Secretary of State to
40 submit legislation repealing all advisory boards and commissions
42 listed in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, sections 12004-I
and 12004-J as well as other advisory boards and commissions with
similar functions.

44 Pursuant to that law, the boards and commissions have been
46 grouped by the subject areas within the jurisdiction of each
48 joint standing committee and each special select committee. This
bill repeals certain boards and commissions identified within the
jurisdiction of the Joint Standing Committee on State and Local
Government.
