COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 811, L.D. 1097, Bill, "An Act Repealing Advisory Boards on Transportation Matters"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §12004-I, sub-§85, as amended by PL 1989, c. 503, Pt. A, §37, is repealed.

Sec. 2. 23 MRSA c. 410-A, as amended, is repealed.

This bill includes Highway Fund deallocations of \$29,000 annually in fiscal years 1993-94 and 1994-95 to the Department of Transportation due to the repeal of the Maine Transportation Capital Improvement Planning Commission.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces the original bill and repeals the Maine Transportation Capital Improvement Planning Commission. The amendment retains the Maine Aeronautical Advisory Board, the Maine State Ferry Advisory Board, the Maine Highway Safety Commission, the Medical Advisory Board and the Travel Information Advisory Council.

The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
