COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 815, L.D. 1101, Bill, "An Act to Encourage Participation in Primary Elections"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2 in the 6th line (page 1, line 11 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "3 weeks" and inserting in its place the following: '15 days' and in the 8th line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Three months weeks" and inserting in its place the following: 'Three-months Fifteen days'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 3 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "3 weeks" and inserting in its place the following: '15 days'
