COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 819, L.D. 1105, Bill, "An Act to Authorize State Agencies to Accept Funds for a Natural Gas Vehicle Demonstration Project"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Authorize State Agencies to Accept Funds for an Alternative-fueled Vehicle Demonstration Project'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1675 is enacted to read:

§1675. Acceptance of funds for alternative-fueled vehicles program

An agency or agencies of the State designated by the Governor to establish an alternative-fueled vehicle demonstration program under the National Energy Policy Act of 1992, Public Law 102-486, Section 409 may accept funds to implement that program from the Federal Government or from any person.

FISCAL NOTE

This bill allows the acceptance of federal and dedicated funds by a state agency or agencies designated by the Governor to establish an alternative-fueled vehicle demonstration project. If federal funds require a state match, General Fund appropriations or Highway Fund allocations may be required.

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8 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

10 This amendment changes the title of the bill and replaces
the bill. The amendment allows designated agencies of State
12 Government to accept funds from the Federal Government or private
entities to finance an alternative-fueled vehicle program under
14 the provisions of the National Energy Policy Act of 1992, Section
409.
