fiscal years 1993-94, 1994-95, 1995-96 and 1996-97, respectively. General Fund appropriations to the department also will need to be increased pursuant to the Constitution of Maine.

The amounts of the additional General Fund appropriations required to meet the constitutional requirement will depend on the final outcome of the current services budget.

The increase of certain license fees will increase fee collections of the Atlantic Sea-Run Salmon Commission. The estimated increases of General Fund revenues are \$4,785 and \$9,570 in fiscal years 1993-94 and 1994-95, respectively.'

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment replaces the bill. It raises the license fees for various hunting, trapping and fishing activities under the jurisdiction of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife and for licenses under the jurisdiction of the Atlantic Sea-Run Salmon Commission.

This amendment also corrects a conflict in the statutes. The Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 7366 requires that fees from the whitewater guide license be credited to the Whitewater Rafting Fund. However, Title 12, section 7370, which creates the Whitewater Rafting Fund, forbids fees from the whitewater guide license from being credited to the Whitewater Rafting Fund. This amendment corrects the conflict by removing language from section 7366 requiring fees from the whitewater guide license to be credited to the Whitewater Rafting Fund.

This amendment also adds a fiscal note.
