

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7151, sub-§3, ¶E is enacted to read:

6 E. A nonresident may obtain a special resident fishing
8 license if that nonresident pays property taxes or makes
10 lease payments on property in the State in an amount of at
12 least \$500 per year. The license may be obtained only from
14 the clerk or agent in the town where the property is located.

16 Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7151, sub-§5, ¶K is enacted to read:

18 K. Special resident fishing license \$22.50
20 (nonresidents who pay property
22 taxes in Maine)

STATEMENT OF FACT

24 This bill establishes a special fishing license for
26 nonresidents who pay property taxes or make lease payments on
28 property of \$500 per year or more in this State.
