

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. Conveyance authorized. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Town of Hermon may convey, by quitclaim deed, the land known as the School House Lot, located at the junction of Union Street and Crogan Road and described in Book 83, Page 274 of the Penobscot County Registry of Deeds. The Town of Hermon shall convey the property to Stephen Allen if the parties are able to agree on a reasonable price for the parcel.
