	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6455, sub-§4, ¶D-1 is enacted to read:
4 6	<u>D-1. Market and sell goods directly related to the functions of the council and deposit all proceeds in the Lobster Promotion Fund;</u>
8	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §6455, sub-§5, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 523,
10	§2, is amended to read:
12	<b>5. Fund established; license surcharge assessed.</b> The Lobster Promotion Fund, referred to in this subchapter as the
14	"fund," is established in the department to carry out the purposes of this subchapter. The council shall administer the
16	fund and the department shall transfer to the fund all money appropriated or received by the department for the purposes of
18	this subchapter. The fund is capitalized from the following annual surcharges assessed on the following licenses issued by
20	the department for-calender-years-1992-and-1993:
22	A. Class I crab and lobster licenses for persons 18 to 69 years of age, \$25;
24	
26	B. Class II crab and lobster licenses, \$50;
28	C. Class III crab and lobster licenses, \$75;
30	D. Wholesale seafood licenses with lobster permits, \$200; and
32	E. Lobster transportation licenses, \$200.
34	A person holding more than one of the licenses listed in this subsection is assessed a surcharge only on the highest
36	surchargeable license held.
38	The Treasurer of State shall hold all surcharges assessed by this subsection in the fund and invest all money in the fund until
40	disbursement is authorized by the council. Interest from investments accrues to the fund.
42	All menow in the fund is subject to allocation by the
44	All money in the fund is subject to allocation by the Legislature. Unexpended balances in the fund at the end of the fiscal year may not lapse but must be carried forward to be used
46	for the same purposes.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill allows the Lobster Promotion Council to market and sell items related to its functions with the proceeds accruing to
the Lobster Promotion Fund. This bill also indefinitely extends the Lobster Promotion Council, which would otherwise expire at
the end of this calendar year.
