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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 844, L.D. 1149, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Enforcement Provisions of the Bureau of Taxation"

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Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

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'Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §175, as amended by PL 1991, c. 820, §§1 to 4, is repealed.

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The elimination of certain Bureau of Taxation enforcement provisions will decrease General Fund revenues by \$500,000 in fiscal year 1993-94 and \$500,000 in fiscal year 1994-95. The corresponding decreases in State-Municipal Revenue Sharing will be \$31,350 and \$31,350, respectively.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment replaces the bill and repeals the power of the State Tax Assessor to prevent the renewal, reissuance or other extension of a license or certificate of authority to conduct a profession, business or trade. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
