COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 851, L.D. 1156, Bill, "An Act to Create the Maine Criminal Justice Information System"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§635." in subsection 2 by striking out all of paragraph C.

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§635." in subsection 2 by relettering the paragraphs to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill allows the Maine Criminal Justice Information Services Policy Board to assess reasonable fees to defray the cost of operating the Maine Criminal Justice Information System. The costs and new dedicated revenues to administer this program can not be determined at this time.

Costs associated with providing oversight and establishing the Maine Criminal Justice Information System, including a policy board, to assist law enforcement agencies throughout the State with information on criminal offenders and crime data can be absorbed by the Department of Public Safety utilizing existing budgeted resources.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment deletes the reference to juvenile records with regard to the development of policies by the Maine Criminal Justice Information System Policy Board because the system will not initially include juvenile records.
