

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §2503, sub-§11-A is enacted to read:

6 11-A. Permits for the location of poles and wires. In
8 addition to issuing the permit pursuant to subsection 5, the
10 municipal licensing authority may also require that an applicant
12 installing wires on poles located on a street in a subdivision
14 approved after the effective date of this subsection allow
16 sufficient space on the poles for the installation of cable and
18 other utility lines.

STATEMENT OF FACT

16 This bill allows municipal licensing authorities to require
18 that the installation of wires on utility poles allow sufficient
space on the poles for cable and other utility lines.
