

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

28 STATEMENT OF FACT

30 Part A repeals the Commission on Safety and Health in the Maine Workplace.

32 Part B repeals the State Advisory Council.

34 Part C repeals the Displaced Homemakers Advisory Council.

36 Part D repeals the Governor's Committee on Employment of People with Disabilities.

38 This bill is submitted in compliance with Public Law 1991, chapter 844, section 8, which requires the Secretary of State to

2 submit legislation repealing all advisory boards and commissions
listed in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, sections 12004-I
4 and 12004-J as well as other advisory boards and commissions with
similar functions.

6 Pursuant to that law, the boards and commissions have been
grouped by the subject areas within the jurisdiction of each
8 joint standing committee and each special select committee. This
bill repeals certain boards and commissions identified within the
10 jurisdiction of the Joint Standing Committee on Labor.
