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## STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment replaces the original bill. The amendment requires the Commissioner of Environmental Protection to report annually to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over energy and natural resource matters on portions of the proposed regulatory agenda οf Department of Environmental Protection that, in judgment, inconsistent with commissioner's are environmental law. The committee is directed to consult with the Commissioner of Environmental Protection and the Chair of the Board of Environmental Protection. The committee is authorized to introduce legislation by majority vote of the full committee to recommend any changes in the department's statutory authority that it finds necessary.

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This amendment also adds an appropriation and a fiscal note.
