HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 871,
L.D. 1180, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Group Life Insurance Laws
Administered by the Maine State Retirement System"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the
following:

'Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the
enacting clause the following:

'Mandate preamble. This measure requires one or more local
units of government to expand or modify activities so as to
necessitate additional expenditures from local revenues but does
not provide funding for at least 90% of those expenditures.
Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21,
two thirds of all of the members elected to each House have
determined it necessary to enact this measure.'

Further amend the amendment in the first paragraph after the
title in the first line (page 1, line 17 in amendment) by
striking out the following: "Amend" and inserting in its place
the following: 'Further amend'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the
fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

This bill makes several technical and clarifying changes,
which may result in minor administrative savings to the Maine
State Retirement System as a result of record-keeping and
calculation simplification.

This bill requires local units of government to make
additional expenditures to provide forms and notification under
the group life insurance laws. Pursuant to the mandate preamble,
the 2/3 vote of all members elected to each House exempts the
State from the constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the
additional local cost of these requirements.'
