COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 871, L.D. 1180, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Group Life Insurance Laws Administered by the Maine State Retirement System"

Amend the bill in section 5 in that part designated "§18062." in subsection 2 by inserting before the last sentence (page 3, line 32 in L.D.) a new sentence to read: 'Notification of the employee's election to continue the insurance under section 18061, subsection 1 must be received by the retirement system within 60 days of the employee's separation.'

Further amend the bill in section 5 in that part designated "§18062." in subsection 3 by striking out all of the last sentence (page 3, lines 42 to 45 in L.D.).

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill makes several technical and clarifying changes, which may result in minor administrative savings to the Maine State Retirement System as a result of record-keeping and calculation simplification.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment specifies the notification period in which an employee who has separated from service must notify the Maine State Retirement System of the employee's decision to continue the life insurance coverage. The amendment also removes a sentence that relieved the retirement system of liability and adds a fiscal note.
