HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 390, L.D. 1185, Bill, "An Act to Increase Access to Primary Care by Redefining the Practice of Advanced Nursing"


Amend the amendment in section 11 in that part designated "~~§2232.~~" in subsection 2 by striking out the last 3 lines (page 4, lines 11 to 13 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following: 'a physician.'

Further amend the amendment in section 11 in that part designated "~~§2233.~~" by striking out all of subsection 2 (page 4, lines 34 to 37 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'2. Education. Has completed a formal master's level education program in advanced nursing in the specialty area of practice.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment removes language from Committee Amendment "A" that permits an advanced registered nurse practitioner to practice in collaboration if that person has completed a formal education certificate program as a nurse midwife or an obstetric and gynecologic nurse practitioner. This amendment also removes language permitting an advanced registered nurse practitioner to fulfill the supervision requirement by being employed by a clinic or hospital that has a medical director who is a physician and instead requires performance of services under the supervision of a physician.
