SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 874, L.D. 1188, "Resolve, to Establish the Academy for Public Service Study Committee"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

Amend the resolve by striking out all of section 5 and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 5. Staff assistance. Resolved: That staffing assistance for the committee must be provided by the University of Maine System and other institutions whose members serve on the committee; and be it further'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The University of Maine System can absorb the miscellaneous expenses of the Academy for Public Service Study Committee, which are estimated to be \$500. Any costs associated with staffing the committee can be absorbed by the University of Maine System and other member institutions.'


