SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 883, L.D. 1197, Bill, "An Act to Apportion the State's Senate, House of Representatives and Congressional Districts"

Amend the bill in section 2 by striking out all of that part designated "§1207." and inserting in its place the following:

'§1207. Congressional districts

The State is divided into 2 districts for the election of Representatives to Congress. The districts are comprised as follows.


1. First District. The First District is comprised of the counties of Cumberland, Kennebec, Lincoln, Sagadahoc and York and the municipalities of Cushing, Friendship, Owls Head, Rockland, Rockport, St. George, South Thomaston, Thomaston, Union, and Warren in Knox County.

2. Second District. The Second District is comprised of the counties of Androscoggin, Aroostook, Franklin, Hancock, Oxford, Penobscot, Piscataquis, Somerset, Waldo and Washington and the municipalities of Appleton, Camden, Hope, Isle au Haut, Matinicus, North Haven, Vinalhaven and Washington in Knox County.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment consolidates Kennebec County in the First Congressional District and places various towns in Knox County in the First and Second Congressional Districts.
