

An Act to Apportion the State's Senate, House of Representatives and Congressional Districts.

Reported by Representative MICHAUD for the Legislative Apportionment Commission pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IV, Part Third, Section 1-A.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §1201, as amended by PL 1993, c. 7, §1, is
4 repealed.

6 Sec. 2. 21-A MRSA §§1202 to 1207 are enacted to read:

8 §1202. Definitions

10 As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise
12 indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.

14 1. Block. "Block" means an area defined as a block in the
United States Census for 1990. A block is the smallest census
16 unit used in this chapter.

18 2. Block group. "Block group" means an area comprising all
of the blocks within a tract or BNA whose census data labels
20 begin with the same digit. There are one to 9 block groups in a
tract or BNA.

22 3. Block numbering area. "Block numbering area" or "BNA"
means that area composed of blocks or block groups that is
24 defined as a block numbering area in the United States Census for
1990.

26 4. Census unit. "Census unit" means a block, block group,
28 BNA or tract.

30 5. Commission. "Commission" means the Legislative
Apportionment Commission established every 10 years pursuant to
32 the Constitution of Maine, Article IV, Part Third, Section 1-A.

34 6. Tract. "Tract" means that area composed of blocks or
block groups that is defined as a tract in the United States
36 Census for 1990.

38 7. United States Census for 1990. "United States Census
for 1990" means the population counts published in both printed
40 and electronic media in March 1991 by the United States Census
Bureau as the data for the State of Maine collected pursuant to
42 Public Law 94-171.

44 §1203. General provisions

46 1. Implementation. The Secretary of State shall implement
the election districts adopted in this chapter pursuant to this
48 Title and the Constitution of Maine. The Secretary of State
shall inform the municipal clerks of the voting district or
50 districts in which each municipality lies and shall provide
copies of this chapter and district maps and narrative
52 geographic descriptions of relevant election districts to those

2 officials. The Secretary of State may resolve ambiguities
3 concerning the location of election district lines consistent
4 with subsection 2 and this chapter.

6 2. Interpretation. Where a road, street, waterway,
7 boundary of a tract, boundary of a block group or boundary of a
8 block is used as a boundary of an election district, the boundary
9 line lies at the center of the street or road, at the thread of
10 the waterway or at the boundary of the tract, block group or
11 block, unless otherwise noted. When a description refers to a
12 bridge or railroad line, the district boundary lies at the center
13 of the bridge or railroad tracks. When a description refers to a
14 railroad spur, it refers to the principal spur in the area. When
15 a description uses the word "ocean," the district boundary line
16 lies coincident with the legal boundary of the particular
17 community along or within the Atlantic Ocean. When an election
18 district includes a particular unorganized territory, it includes
19 that unorganized territory as described in the United States
20 Census for 1990, whether the territory is organized or
21 unorganized on the effective date of this chapter. Unless
22 otherwise noted, a district that names a municipality includes
23 all of the municipality.

24 §1204. Reapportionment

26 The state legislative districts established in this chapter
27 must be reapportioned pursuant to the Constitution of Maine,
28 Article IV, Part Third, Section 1-A, and congressional districts
29 must be reapportioned as follows.

30 1. Procedure. In 1993 and every 10 years thereafter, when
31 the Secretary of State has received notification of the number of
32 congressional seats to which the State is entitled and the
33 Federal Decennial Census population count is final, the
34 commission shall review the existing congressional districts. If
35 the districts do not conform to Supreme Judicial Court
36 guidelines, the commission shall reapportion the State into
37 congressional districts.

38 In making such a reapportionment, the commission shall ensure
39 that each congressional district is formed of compact and
40 contiguous territory and crosses political subdivisions the least
41 number of times necessary to establish districts as equally
42 populated as possible. The commission shall submit its plan to
43 the Clerk of the House of Representatives no later than 120
44 calendar days after the convening of the Legislature in which
45 apportionment is required. The Legislature shall enact the
46 submitted plan of the commission or a plan of its own in regular
47 or special session by a vote of 2/3 of the members of each house
48 within 30 calendar days after the plan is submitted to the Clerk
49 of the House of Representatives. This action is subject to the
50 of the House of Representatives. This action is subject to the

2 Governor's approval, as provided in the Constitution of Maine,
3 Article IV, Part Third, Section 2.

4 2. Court apportionment. In the event that the Legislature
5 fails to make an apportionment within 120 calendar days of the
6 convening of the session in which apportionment is required, the
7 Supreme Judicial Court shall make the apportionment within 60
8 days following the period in which the Legislature is required to
9 act but fails to do so. In making the apportionment, the Supreme
10 Judicial Court shall take into consideration plans and briefs
11 filed by the public with the court during the first 30 days of
12 the period in which the court is required to apportion.

13 3. Judicial review. The Supreme Judicial Court has
14 original jurisdiction to hear any challenge to an apportionment
15 law enacted by the Legislature, as registered by any citizen or
16 group of citizens. If a challenge is sustained, the Supreme
17 Judicial Court shall make the apportionment.

§1207. Congressional districts

The State is divided into 2 districts for the election of
Representatives to Congress. The districts are comprised as
follows.

1. First District. The First District is comprised of the
counties of Cumberland, Knox, Lincoln, Sagadahoc and York and the
municipalities of Augusta, Belgrade, Benton, Chelsea, Clinton,
Farmingdale, Fayette, Gardiner, Hallowell, Litchfield,
Manchester, Mount Vernon, Oakland, Pittston, Randolph, Readfield,
Rome, Sidney, Vassalboro, Vienna, Waterville, West Gardiner,
Windsor, Winslow and Winthrop in Kennebec County.

2. Second District. The Second District is comprised of
the counties of Androscoggin, Aroostook, Franklin, Hancock,
Oxford, Penobscot, Piscataquis, Somerset, Waldo and Washington
and the municipalities of Albion, China, Monmouth, Unity Township
and Wayne in Kennebec County.

Sec. 3. Legislative findings. The Legislature finds that the
State's population growth during the period from completion of
the 1980 federal census to completion of the 1990 federal census
and population shifts within the State during the same time
period have combined to render the present apportionment of the
State's Senate, House of Representatives and 2 congressional
districts unconstitutional. The Legislature further finds that
the apportionment of the State's Senate, House of Representatives
and 2 congressional districts contained in the final report of
the Legislative Apportionment Commission, presented to the
Legislature pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IV,
Part First, Sections 2 and 3 and Article IV, Part Second, Section
2, satisfies the constitutional requirement of a fair and
reasonable apportionment when viewed by the standards of
population equality, contiguity of districts, compactness of
districts and minimization of crossing of the boundaries of
political subdivisions. The Legislature also finds that the
delicate balancing of diverse political interests required in
apportionment matters has been achieved by the Legislative
Apportionment Commission and that substantial alteration of the
plans proposed by the Legislative Apportionment Commission will
detract, both now and in the future, from the important objective
of apportioning the legislative and congressional districts by
the politically balanced process of the Legislative Apportionment
Commission and by the Legislature itself.
