If a landlord 24 fails to maintain a rental unit in compliance with the standards of subsection 1 and the reasonable cost of compliance is less than \$190 \$250 or an amount equal to 1/2 the monthly rent, 26 whichever is greater, the tenant shall notify the landlord in 28 writing of his the tenant's intention to correct the condition at the landlord's expense. If the landlord fails to comply within 30 14 days after being notified by the tenant in writing by certified mail, return receipt requested, or as promptly as 32 conditions require in case of emergency, the tenant may cause the work to be done in-a-werkmanlike-manner with due professional care with the same quality of materials as are being repaired. 34 Installation and servicing of electrical, oil burner or plumbing 36 equipment shall must be by a professional licensed pursuant to Title 32. After submitting to the landlord an itemized 38 statement, the tenant may deduct from his the tenant's rent the

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actual and reasonable cost or the fair and reasonable value of

the work, not exceeding the amount specified in this subsection. This subsection does not apply to repairs of damage caused by the

tenant or the tenant's invitee.'

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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " to H.P. 900, L.D. 1215

STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment raises the amount for repairs that a tenant may deduct from rent. It provides that deductions from rent may not be made for repairs of damage that is caused by the tenant or the tenant's invitee.
