An Act to Amend the Charter of the East Pittston Water District.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, changes must be made to the charter of the East 6 Pittston Water District; and

Whereas, the changes must take effect immediately to ensure the proper operation of the district; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. P&SL 1987, c. 144, §13-B is enacted to read:

22 <u>Sec. 13-B. Property tax exempt.</u> The property of the district 22 is exempt from all taxation in the Town of Pittston.

Sec. 2. Emergency clause; referendum; effective date. In view of 24 the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved, except that the part making the property of the East 26 Pittston Water District exempt from all taxation in the Town of Pittston takes effect only for the purpose of permitting its 28 submission to the legal voters of the East Pittston Water District, resident in the district, at the next regular town or 30 at a special town meeting to be called and held for the purpose by December 31, 1993. The election must be called, advertised 32 and conducted according to the law related to municipal elections; provided, however, that the municipal officers of the 34 town are not required to prepare for posting, nor the town clerk 36 to post, a new list of voters and, for the purpose of registration of voters, the board of voter registration must be 38 in session on the secular day next preceding the special election. The town clerk of the town shall prepare the required ballots, on which the town clerk shall reduce the subject matter 40 of this Act to the following question:

"Shall the charter that created the East Pittston Water District be amended to make the property of the district exempt from all taxation in the Town of Pittston?"

The voters shall indicate by a cross or check mark placed against the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same. This Act takes effect immediately upon its acceptance by a majority of the legal voters voting at the election.
