2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §121 is enacted to read:**

6 **§121. Consumer information**

8 Annually on or before November 1st, the commission shall
10 provide information to every customer of a public utility. The
12 information must include a statement of the profits for that
14 utility for the immediately preceding fiscal year and a summary
16 of the most recent schedules filed under section 304 by that
18 utility. The information may be provided in a postcard or
20 brochure format.

22 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

This bill requires the Public Utilities Commission to provide to customers of a public utility information stating the utility's profits and a summary of its rates, tolls and charges.
