COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 926, L.D. 1249, Bill, "An Act to Change Public Hearing Requirements for Certain Railroad Grade Crossing Projects"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

Eliminating a notice and hearing requirement for the Railroad Highway Grade Crossing Improvement Program will result in savings of federal funds estimated at approximately \$14,000 per year to the Department of Transportation. These funds will be available for other uses as allowed by conditions set forth by the Federal Government.'
