COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 927, L.D. 1250, "Resolve,  
Directing the Bureau of Health to Study the Problem of Violence  
among Children, Teens and Young Adults"

Amend the resolve in section 1 by inserting after the first  
sentence (page 1, line 34 in L.D.) a new sentence to read: 'The  
Division of Maternal and Child Health shall collaborate with the  
Department of Corrections, the Office of Substance Abuse and the  
Bureau of Children with Special Needs in conducting this study.'

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the  
statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Bureau of Health within the Department of Human Services  
will incur some minor additional costs to prepare and submit the  
required report. These costs can be absorbed within the  
department's existing budgeted resources.

The Departments of Corrections and Mental Health and Mental  
Retardation will incur some minor additional costs to collaborate  
with the Bureau of Health on this study. These costs can be  
absorbed within the respective department's existing budgeted  
resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires the Division of Maternal and Child  
Health to collaborate with the Department of Corrections, the  
Office of Substance Abuse and the Bureau of Children with Special  
Needs in carrying out the study. The amendment also adds a  
fiscal note to the resolve.
