Sec. 1. Authorization to sue the Town of Freeport. Resolved: That, notwithstanding any statute or common law to the contrary, 2 Stephanie Burton, or her legal representative, who claims to have suffered damages as a result of an injury sustained in an 4 automobile accident that occurred in 1989 and in which the other vehicle was operated by an employee of the Town of Freeport, is 6 authorized to bring a civil action against the Town of Freeport, 8 but not against individual past or present employees of the town.

10 This action may be brought in the Cumberland County Superior Court within one year from the date this resolve is approved. Liability and damages, including punitive damages, must be 12 determined according to state law as in litigation between The action may be heard by a Justice of the 14 individuals.
