Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

1991, c. 13, is further amended to read: 4 For accomplishing the purposes of this act, the water district, 6 through its trustees, without-the-necessity-of-a with a necessary vote of the inhabitants of the district, is authorized to borrow money, not exceeding \$2,000,000, for long terms and temporarily, 10 and to issue therefor the interest-bearing negotiable bonds and notes of the district for the purpose of refunding indebtedness so created; of paying any necessary expenses and 12 liabilities incurred under the provisions of this act, including 14 the expenses incurred in the creation of the district; in acquiring the properties and franchises of the Kingfield Water 16 Company, by purchase or otherwise; of securing sources of supply; land; taking water and paying damages; 1aying constructing, maintaining and operating a water system and making 18
