An Act Authorizing the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to Establish Open and Closed Seasons on the Hunting of Deer.

#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA 37457, sub- 1, A, as amended by PL 1991, c. 170, is further amended to read:

Except as otherwise provided in this section or by rule Α. adopted by the commissioner pursuant to this section, there is an open season on deer in each calendar year in all counties of the State from the 5th Monday preceding Thanksgiving to Nevember--30th <u>the first Saturday in</u> In--any--year--when--November--30th--falls--on--a December. Wednesday, -- Thursday -- or - Friday, -- the - commissioner -- may, -- by rule,-extend-the-open-season-on-deer-to-the-first-Saturday in-December -- In any year - in which the commissioner -extends the - season - beyond - November - 30th, - the - commissioner - shall - by rule-open-the-season-in-the-northern-portion-of-the-State-a week-before-opening-the-season-in-the-southern-portion-of the-State---The-commissioner-may-by-rule-establish-for-this purpose-a-northern-and-a-southern-sone-

#### Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7457, sub-§1, ¶I is enacted to read:

I. The commissioner may lengthen the open season on deer in any part of the State to maintain deer populations in balance with available habitat, subject to the following.

(1) The demarcation of each area must follow recognizable physical boundaries, such as rivers, roads and railroad rights-of-way.

(2) The determination of these areas must be made and published prior to August 1st of each year.

(3) The commissioner may implement a permit system to regulate hunter participation in the lengthened open season and the number, sex and age of deer harvested.

(4) Special hunts must take place between the close of the special muzzle-loading season and January 31st.

(5) The commissioner may establish limits on deer harvested during the lengthened open season.

(6) The commissioner may specify types of weapons to be used during the lengthened open season.

(7) The commissioner may adopt rules necessary for the administration, implementation, enforcement and interpretation of this paragraph.

### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill removes the framework for setting the deer hunting season that is now in the laws and gives the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife the flexibility needed to establish deer hunting seasons that maximize hunting opportunity and ensure the welfare of the resource.

The bill also gives the commissioner the authority to 12 regulate deer populations in problem areas, including islands, where the herd is not, or can not, be controlled under the 14 existing system by establishing special hunts to remove deer on a quota basis during early winter.
