HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 951,  
L.D. 1280, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Laws Related to Concealed  
Weapon Permits"

Amend the amendment in that part designated "§2002-A." in  
the first paragraph by striking out all of the 6th and 7th  
sentences (page 1, lines 31 to 39 in amendment)

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the 2nd  
indented paragraph from the end (page 2, lines 11 to 16 in  
amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the bill in section 3 by striking out all of  
subsection 6 and inserting in its place the following:

'6. **Unorganized territory.** Any A resident of an  
unorganized territory shall make written application to the  
~~appropriate--issuing--authority--in--any--municipality--nearest--the~~  
~~unorganized--territory~~ Chief of the State Police and the  
application, fee and permit provisions of this section shall  
apply.'

This amendment clarifies that the State Police issues  
permits for the unorganized territory.
