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

'FISCAL NOTE

This bill establishes a universal access health care system operated by a new entity, the Maine Health Care Agency. The fiscal impact of all the changes proposed in this bill and the

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additional General Fund appropriations and transfers required to implement this bill can not be determined.

These changes, among others, include the elimination of the Maine Health Care Finance Commission and its funding source and provides for the transfer of any remaining balance in that fund to the Maine Health Care Agency. It also provides for the transition of certain Department of Human Services functions and staff to the Maine Health Care Agency, increases the cigarette tax and dedicates the increase to the Maine Health Care Trust Fund, provides for a working capital advance and permits the Maine Health Care Agency to establish, by rule, eligibility and premium requirements. This bill will also indirectly affect the workers' compensation system, insurance premium tax collections and the state employee health insurance program.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Banking and Insurance. The amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill. This amendment also conforms existing law to current drafting standards.

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
