

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6501, sub-§8 is enacted to read:

4 8. Diver certification required. A person who fishes or
6 takes fish while diving must show proof of diver certification
8 before being issued a commercial fishing license.
