COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 417, L.D. 1326, Bill, "An Act to Require that All Interest on Escrowed Assessments on Utilities Be Used for the Benefit of the Public Utilities Commission and the Office of the Public Advocate"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill requires that as of July 1, 1995 all interest on the Public Utilities Commission Regulatory Fund and the Public Advocate Regulatory Fund be credited to those funds. This will reduce undedicated General Fund revenues by approximately \$73,400 annually beginning in fiscal year 1995-96.

The estimated increases of dedicated revenues to the Public Utilities Commission Regulatory Fund will be approximately \$65,000 annually beginning in fiscal year 1995-96. The increase in dedicated revenues to the Public Advocate Regulatory Fund will be approximately \$8,400 annually beginning in fiscal year 1995-96.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
