Maine State Retirement System.**

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §17751, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1991, c. 878,**
4 **§1, is further amended to read:**

5 **3. Board determination. The Except as provided in**
6 **subsection 3-A, the board shall determine by appropriate rules**
7 **how much service in any year qualifies for one year's service**
8 **credit. Service rendered for the full normal working time in any**
9 **year qualifies for one year's service credit. The board shall**
10 **provide in its rule related to the determination of creditable**
11 **service for state employees that any part-time or seasonal state**
12 **employee who was employed during the period beginning January 1,**
13 **1989 and ending June 30, 1991 is credited with a full year of**
14 **creditable service for each year in which that employee is**
15 **employed for 1,000 or more hours, for as long as that employee is**
16 **employed by the State. The board's rule must also treat in the**
17 **same manner any employee first employed before July 1, 1991 who**
18 **is employed in a position that is in a career ladder in which the**
19 **employee is required to move from full-time status to seasonal**
20 **status when accepting a promotion in the employee's career**
21 **ladder. Section 17001, subsection 13, paragraph E does not apply**
22 **to an employee who is credited with a full year of creditable**
23 **service under this provision. Each state department or agency**
24 **shall submit to the retirement system a list of all employees to**
25 **whom this provision applies, in the manner and time provided by**
26 **board rule.**

27 **Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §17751, sub-§3-A is enacted to read:**

28 **3-A. Creditable service for educational technicians. A**
29 **full year of creditable service is granted to any educational**
30 **technician for any school year during which that employee is**
31 **employed for 1,000 or more hours in a part-time or seasonal**
32 **position.**

33 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

34 This bill provides that an educational technician receives a
35 full year of creditable service for any school year during which
36 that employee is employed for 1,000 or more hours in a part-time
37 or seasonal position.
