2	Sec.1. 17-A MRSA §908 is enacted to read:

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	1. A person is guilty of rental housing fraud if, with
8	intent to defraud, that person obtains rental housing that the
	person knows is available only for compensation and that person
10	by deception avoids payment for that housing.
12	2. Rental housing fraud is:
14	A. A Class D crime if the value of the rental housing exceeds \$500; or
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	B. A Class E crime if the value of the rental housing does
18	not exceed \$500.
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	STATEMENT OF FACT

	This bill establishes the crime of rental housing fraud when
24	a person, with the intent to defraud, obtains rental housing and by deception avoids paying rent.

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
