COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 433, L.D. 1343, "Resolve,
to Clear Title to Land Owned by James Mercier in Unity, Maine"

Amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the
statement of fact the following:

'The State's interest must be conveyed for the amount of
\$250 to cover the costs associated with transfer of title.
Transfer documents must be prepared by James Mercier for review
and approval by the Bureau of Public Lands.'

FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Conservation will receive \$250 of
additional dedicated revenue from the new property owner for the
legal costs incurred for the property transfer. The new property
owner is also responsible for the preparation of all transfer
documents.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires James Mercier, the petitioning
owner, to pay \$250 to the State to cover the costs associated
with the transfer of interest in the land in Unity and to be
responsible for the preparation of the transfer documents. The
amendment also adds a fiscal note.
