

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7315, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:

6 1-A. Mandatory revocation. If a guide violates a provision
8 of this Title that is punishable by a fine of not less than
\$1,000 and at least 3 days in jail as provided in section 7901,
the commissioner shall revoke the guide's license for 3 years.

14 This bill specifies that the Commissioner of Inland
16 Fisheries and Wildlife shall revoke for 3 years the license of a
18 guide who violates a provision of the fish and wildlife laws that
is punishable by a fine of not less than \$1,000 and at least 3
days in jail.
