COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1020, L.D. 1366, Bill, "An Act to Undedicate Certain Revenues of the Department of Environmental Protection"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill will undedicate the fines and penalties collected by the Department of Environmental Protection, which will provide additional revenues to the General Fund. The bill will require additional sections that adjust certain allocations and appropriations for fiscal years 1993-94 and 1994-95. The amounts of these adjustments will depend on final legislative action on the 1994-95 current services budget and can not be determined at this time.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment allows most licensing revenues to remain dedicated to the Department of Environmental Protection and adds a fiscal note to the bill.
