An Act to Grant Conditional Licensure to Social Work Graduates from Schools That Are Awaiting Accreditation.

### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §7053, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1985, c. 736, §11, is further amended to read:

Licensed master social worker. As a licensed master social worker, an applicant shall must have received either a masters or doctoral degree in social work or social welfare from an accredited educational institution, shall have demonstrated to the satisfaction of the board adherence to the ethics of the social work profession and shall have successfully completed the examination prescribed by the board. After meeting these qualifications, the applicant shall-receive receives a "licensed master social worker" license. If an applicant has received either a masters or doctoral degree in social work or social welfare from an educational institution that is not accredited but is in the process of being accredited, has demonstrated to the satisfaction of the board adherence to the ethics of the social work profession and has successfully completed the examination prescribed by the board, the applicant receives a "licensed master social worker, conditional" license until the educational institution has been accredited. If the school does not receive accreditation, the license is revoked. In addition, any person wishing to practice social work in a clinical setting shall--receive receives a "licensed master social worker, conditional" license.

This bill amends the requirements for a licensed master social worker's license so that it allows a person who received a masters or doctoral degree from a school that is not accredited but is applying to be accredited to receive a conditional license until the school has been accredited. If the school is not accredited, the license is revoked.
